#### Background

## Tauranga has one of the worst rates per capita in New Zealand for sending waste to landfill.



#### The Proposal

We propose introducing the following separate kerbside collection services for residential households from the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2021:



#### **The Proposed Services**

| Service  | Frequency   | Bin  |
|--|-------------|--|
| Mixed recyclables<br>(paper & cardboard, plastics grade 1<br>& 2, food and drink cans) | Fortnightly | Choice of 80L, 140L or 240L<br>Wheelie bin |
| Food Scraps  | Weekly      | 33L bin & kitchen top caddy                |
| Rubbish  | Fortnightly | Choice of 80L, 140L or 240L<br>Wheelie bin |
| Glass recycling (existing)   | Fortnightly | 45L crate                                  |

\* Subject to Councillor approval

#### **Guiding Principles**

- Meet Environmental Outcomes: reduce the amount of waste going to landfill, reduce the number of service vehicles for certain services and ensure there is a long term sustainable business solution for Tauranga city.
- **Keep it Simple:** so the level of service is achievable and realistic
- **Customer First**: to ensure the best solutions are provided to our customers
- **Do lt Right:** to encourage customers and contractors to support the outcomes of this project
- **Be Consistent with LTP Outcomes**: to reference to the key messages presented during the Long Term Plan 2018-28

#### Benefits

- Reduce household waste to landfill
- Better use of resources
- Reduced traffic + congestion (reduced carbon footprint)
- Lower cost for average household and choice of bin size/cost for rubbish and/or recycling
- Ability to collect data to help guide behavior change campaigns
- National consistency in Council-led waste and recycling collection services
